The Network of EECCA Water Management Organisations
The network of EECCA Water Management Organisations (WMOs) is a regional cooperation mechanism for water management in the Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia (EECCA) region. It was established in 1997 and is currently composed of 12 member states: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Romania, Russia, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, and Turkmenistan. The network's primary objective is to improve water management practices and policies in the region, with a focus on sustainable water use, water quality, and water security. The network achieves its goals through a variety of activities, including technical assistance, capacity building, and policy development. It also serves as a platform for regional cooperation and dialogue on water management issues.
